Summer semester:

Summer training

The student must perform summer training 300 hours divided into (200 Credit hours) under the supervision of staff members in a pharmaceutical institutions, in addition to 100 credit hours clinical training in an educational hospital.





Assessment

Maximum scores of each course is the summation of periodical, practical, oral and written scores. Minimum scores of success is 60% More than 30% in the written exam is an obligatory requirement for success.
